Perusahaan Umum Prasarana Perikanan Samudera (Perum PPS) as a State Owned Enterprise tasked to manage Fishery Port Infrastructure established under Government Regulation (PP) Number 2 of 1990.

August 2021

The Transformation From Perum to (Persero)

From PP No. 76 of 2021 Perum Perikanan Indonesia is transformed into Perusahaan Perseroan (Persero).

December 2021

Join into Food Holding (ID FOOD)

This regulation is stipulated by PP No. 118 of 2021.

January 2013

The Change of Company's Name

Pursuant to Government Regulation (PP) Number 9/2013 Perum Perindo assumed duties and responsibilities to manage state assets for the exploration and goods-services provision and profit accumulation and the development of fishery system business for the users of fishery Port services, i.e. the fishermen in particularly and fishery communities in general.


